## Thematic Exhibit “390 Years of Kunchi”

9/19 (Thu) – 10/20 (Sun)

The Nagasaki Kunchi is the autumn festival of Suwa Shrine, with origins dating back to 1634. It is held annually on October 7-9, when city districts take turns to dedicate colorful performances to the gods. In this exhibition you can see paintings and photographs of the festival, costumes used in past performances, and other items related to the districts performing in this year’s festival.



# Thematic Exhibit “Chinese Painting and Calligraphy Introduced from the Late Edo to the Meiji Period”

With the decline and fall of the Qing dynasty (1644-1912), paintings and calligraphy works by famous Chinese artists that had never been seen in Japan started to reach the country. This exhibition focuses on works that were introduced to Japan from the late Edo period (1603-1868) to the Meiji period (1868-1912), and were admired by the artists of Nagasaki.
